We will post the final standings on the web site once the last games of the season are finished. The place you finished in the regular season determines which game you will play on Saturday. If you finish 1 or 2 in U-14, you have a bye for the first round of matches. If you finished 3rd, you are team 3 in the playoff schedule, if you finished 4th, team 4, if you finished 5th, you are team 5 and if you finished 6th, you are team 6. Your next match is determined if you win (W) or lose (L) your match. For example, if you finished 4th in U-14, your first match is Match A14 at 9:00 4 v. 5 at MILL.. If you win your match, your next match is match C14 12:30 1 v. WA14 at MILL. If you win that match, your final match will be G14 10:45 WC14 v. WE14 at MILL.

It is important that we all continue to follow the club's **fair play, equal play** policy. Although it is the playoffs, every player still needs to play the same amount of time on the field as every other player. It is not acceptable to play your stronger players more just because it is the playoffs. Every player deserves the chance to succeed as much as every other player.

Let's keep showing positive support and encouragement for our officials. This is the showcase event for Canmore Minor Soccer. It's a perfect time to show everyone our appreciation of the great job our refs and lines people do.

If a game is tied after full time, we will go straight to a penalty shoot out. We don't have time in the schedule to play extra time (overtime). Each team picks 5 different players to take penalties. Keep the same goalie for all of the penalty shots. If the score is tied after both team's 5 players have taken their shot, each team chooses another different player to shoot. Continue with different players until one team has one more goal than the other.

U-14 games will consist of two 40 minute halves with a 10 minute half time.
